TRAINING ON SOCIAL ASPECT OF SUSTAINABILITY



Basic Fire Safety Training Programme of Staff and Students conducted on December 11th 2023 to give knowledge about Fire Extinguishing Methods




Induction Training Programme for Staff conducted on December 12th, 2023, for their smooth entry into the organization by providing them with the information they require to get started
