The Ethics Committee is a multidisciplinary body comprising professionals from diverse fields to provide comprehensive oversight.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Key responsibilities include:

- 1. Ethical Review: Evaluating research proposals to ensure they comply with ethical guidelines and do not compromise participant welfare.
- **2. Monitoring Compliance**: Overseeing ongoing research to ensure adherence to approved protocols and ethical standards.
- **3.** Guidance and Consultation: Providing researchers with ethical guidance and addressing any concerns related to research conduct.
- **4. Policy Development**: Formulating and updating institutional policies to align with national and international ethical standards.

SUB-COMMITTEES

Recognizing the specialized nature of certain research areas, the institution has established sub-committees, such as the Institutional Ethics Sub-Committee (IESC) and the Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC). The IESC focuses on the ethical review of biomedical research involving human participants, ensuring that studies adhere to ethical principles and regulatory requirements. The IAEC oversees research involving animal subjects, ensuring humane treatment and compliance with ethical standards.

TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING

The Ethics Committee is also involved in the education and training of researchers, administrative staff, and support personnel. This includes organizing workshops and seminars on ethical issues, ensuring that all stakeholders are informed about the ethical aspects of research.
